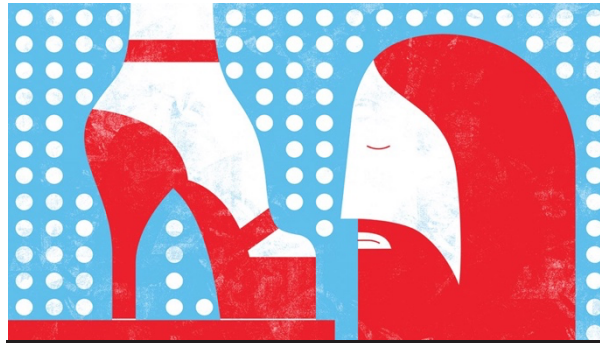


In Las Vegas as it is in Heaven



Prayer Guide

Pre -Trip Prayers

As you prepare for your trip you may experience different obstacles that try to keep you from going. These are some specific things you can pray for yourself & your teammates as you prepare to GO!

- **Against a Spirit of Fear** that would try to cause anxiousness or doubt about God's calling for them to go or fear about confronting the darkness in 'Sin City'. *2 Timothy 1:7*
- **Provision** for funding, God to provide from unexpected and unusual places. *Philippians 4:19*
- **Boldness** to ask people to partner with them to pray, give financially, and boldness to share the gospel. *2 Corinthians 3:12*
- **Creativity** in fundraising and scheduling to be gone from work, home, and family. *Ephesians 2:10*
- **Prepared Heart** for God to reveal in their hearts any unconfessed sin, they would have a willing spirit, and be teachable. *Mark 4:25*
- **Against a Spirit of Procrastination** in the details of trip deadlines that could prevent them from going. *1 Peter 5:8*

Day 1 Travel

Begin by praying for Travel Mercies as they fly to Las Vegas.

Ask God to put men and women of favor in place at the airports, check in, security, and upon arrival in Vegas.

“For the Lord God will go before you and the God of Israel will be your rear guard.”

Isaiah 52:12

- **Favor** as the team travels, to make all their connections and arrive with all bags. *Psalms 90:17*
- **Connection** with new team members as they arrive. *1 Thessalonians 5:11*
- **Renewed Passion** for the local workers, Vegas House of Prayer, Survivors, and team as they minister among the sexually exploited and addicted, homeless, and those in the sex industry. *Isaiah 40:31*
- **Divine Encounters** with people on the flights, airports, and upon arrival in Las Vegas. *Acts 8:26-39*
- **Focus** on the mission ahead and not distractions from home. *Matthew 6:33*
- **Fearlessness** to step into the unknown, uncomfortable, and unfamiliar to boldly proclaim the Gospel. *2 Timothy 1:7*

Lastly for **Protection**.

Ask God to send His angel armies to surround the team as they travel the highways and interstates. That the drivers would have quick eyes and sharp minds to anticipate any movement. Protection from any traveling issues with transportation to/from the airport, planes, weather, or delayed bags. *2 Thessalonians 3:3-5*

“For He will command His angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways” – Psalm 91:1

Day 2 Ministry / Discipleship

Begin by praying for **Divine Appointments**.

Ask God to set up divine appointments and open doors for ministry that only He can make possible. To prepare the hearts of the Show Girls with dreams and visions of Jesus. That hearts would be softened and receptive to the gospel.

“And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should. Colossians 4:3-4

- **Anointing** that will break the yoke of darkness as team members boldly proclaim the gospel. Luke 4:18
- **Boldness** to confront darkness and overcome feelings of inadequacy. To step out in prophetic evangelism. Acts 28:31
- **Release of Control** and an embracing of God’s power to direct steps. Proverbs 3:5-6
- **Spirit of Encouragement** to fill each team member as they walk the strip and break strongholds over the oppressed. Psalms 112:6-7
- **Provision** for the women and their families who are in the sex industry who desire to leave and pursue a relationship with Jesus. Philippians 4:19
- **Discernment** as team members interact with strip club owners, Show Girls, and others held hostage by the enemy. Hebrews 5:14

Lastly, for the **Spirit of Salvation** like the seeds that fell on fertile soil in the Parable of the Sower, ask the Lord to make fertile ground and prepare hearts to receive the gospel.

“I will give them a heart to know me, that I am the Lord. They will be my people, and I will be their God, for they will return to me with all their heart.” Jeremiah 24:7

DAY 3 Ministry / Discipleship

Begin by Praying for **Protection and Safety**.

Pray for your missionaries’ safety and protection. Ask the Lord to protect them against all illness (including Covid-19), injury and distractions. The team will divide into smaller teams and do ministry in the homeless corridor.

“The Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.” Psalms 121:8

- **Open Doors for gospel** conversations and with people in authority in strip clubs, homeless camps, and on the strip. Colossians 4:3
- **Favor with Authorities** in places the team will be doing street worship, prayer eating, and other ministry sites. Proverbs 21:1
- **Perseverance** when it’s hard to endure the heat or hear stories of trauma from women in the sex industry or homelessness. James 1
- **Increased Faith** to match the movement of what God is doing in Vegas. Matthew 17:20
- **Compassion** for the homeless, the prostitute, the lost, the broken, the one held captive by the lies of the enemy. Matthew 9:36
- **Spirit of Peace** over their family back at home while they are away 1 Peter 5:7
- **Spirit of Unity** over each team member and ministry partners. Colossians 2:2-3

Lastly, Pray for a **Servant’s Heart**. Just as Christ humbled himself and took on the nature of a servant, so must each one of us. Pray for God to give the team the nature of a servant, learning to serve one another without an agenda.

“Have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness “Philippians 2:5-7

DAY 4 Ministry / Discipleship

Begin by praying for **Seeing the Unseen**

Pray for God to open the eyes of your missionary to see the unseen. When they feel surrounded, or defeated, pray God would reveal His mighty presence encamped around them. To walk with their Father’s eyes and heart for the broken, hurting, marginalized, and forgotten.

“Don’t be afraid,” the prophet answered. “Those who are with us are more than those who are with them.” And Elisha prayed, “Open his eyes, Lord, so that he may see.” Then the Lord opened the servant’s eyes, and he looked and saw the hills full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.
2 Kings 6:16-17

- **Words Would Be Given** as they Proclaim the Gospel *Ephesians 6:19*
- **Right Place/Right Time/Right People** as the team ministers to Show girls, Johns, Street Performers, strip club owners, strippers, and the homeless. *Proverbs 3:5-6*
- **Barriers Would Be Broken and Strongholds Would Be Exposed and Crushed** on the strip, in the homeless corridor, on Fremont Street, along the strip, prayer eating in international restaurants, in the casinos, Brothels, and every place they put their feet. *2 Corinthians 10:4*
- **Stand Firm** against the opposition of the enemy and stand in their spiritual authority. *Ephesians 6:11*
- **Satan’s Opposition Would Be Stopped** and the darkness would be disrupted. *Isaiah 54:17*
- **Clarity** in Communication, direction, and listening to the voice of the Holy Spirit. *James 1:19*
- **Salvation** Team Members would lead someone to Jesus. *Revelation 3:20*

Lastly, Darkness Would Be Pushed Back.

Missionaries walk boldly into some of the darkest areas of the earth. They confront spiritual and physical oppression that we can’t imagine. Working among the homeless, praying for women in the sex industry and walking the streets of ‘Sin City’ is filled with oppressive darkness. Darkness is so thick that the oppression can feel overwhelming. Pray the light of Jesus would shine through each team member, intimidating the darkness and releasing captives from oppression as they share the Gospel.

DAY 5 Free Day/Travel Home

Begin by praying for **Travel Mercies** as they return home..

When you return home, you will experience many different things. You experienced mighty moves of God on your trip were a part of a united community for the advancement of the Gospel. Don’t keep the stories in that God did- Share them!

“for the Lord will go before you, the God of Israel will be your rear guard.” Isaiah 52:12

- **Protection** from any traveling issues to/from the airport, planes, weather, etc. Psalms 91
- **Reminded of God’s faithfulness** to sustain them throughout the trip. Psalms 33:4
- **Divine Encounters** in shops, restaurants, airplanes and airports. Psalms 37:24
- **Steadfastness** to stay on the course God set before them. 1 Corinthians 15:58
- **Faithfulness** to remain in the AWE FACTORS. Acts 2:42-43
- **Boldness and Fearlessness** to share all God has done on their trip. 2 Timothy 1:7
- **Lasting Fruit** to continue as they go home. John 15:16
- **Eyes to See Divine Encounters** in their sphere of influence, workplace, friendships, and family relationships. Matthew 13:16

Lastly, Pray for their Return to The Mission Field.

Women are half of the Body of Christ. Their unique calling gives them influence in their home, the lives of their children, community, culture, and church. Pray that God continues to call them to invest their holiday breaks, summers, vacations, and future in the furtherance of the gospel to all nations.

“Then he said to his disciples, “The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.” Matthew 9:37-38
