What are OVCs?

In the Bible an orphan is a child who has lost their father; their spiritual guide, protector, teacher, and provider.



Project Hope Worldwide helps kids who have lost one or both parents, who live in places where they are in danger of facing harm due to poverty, neglect, malnutrition, lack of education and healthcare, and are without someone to help them live a life that honors God. We act as spiritual family.
