One of the many ways Awe Star Missions embraces the Great Commission is through mobilizing students, families, women, and medical professionals in domestic and international mission trips. Of the many missions, Awe Star focuses at least two medical relief trips a year specifically to use medicine as a bridge to the gospel among Refugees, Muslims, and other unreached people groups.

In January, an Awe Star Medical Relief team flew into Lebanon and served in the Baqaa Valley on the border of Syria, in conjunction with the Lebanese Municipal, Syrian Refugee Camp leaders, and the Lebanese military. The Awe Star medical team saw over 1,100 patients (moms, dads, grandparents, and children) in the Refugee camps. In Lebanon, the Syrian people are seen as a nuisance, inconvenience, and drain on the economy. Many are subject to labor trafficking, as they work for fuel, food, and permission to stay on the local Lebanese farmland, working off debts they can never repay. They live at a constant disadvantage and are racially discriminated against. Many do not have access to medical care or medications. As a ministry we see it as a privilege to serve the Syrian people and offer them hope that outlives their circumstances.



In July, Awe Star will be sending a Medical Relief team into the The Gambia, West Africa, with the approval of the Ministry of Health. The Gambia has 14 unreached people groups and is the smallest country in Africa. A nation of only 2 million people that has little to no access to medical care or the gospel. The Gambia is 96% Islamic. Awe Star has been invested in advancing the gospel in this nation for over 20 years. Through incredible partners in the country, we have been able to see literally thousands of Muslims come to Jesus and be discipled. Our medical relief trip enhances the work on the ground and gives credibility to the local church among thousands of Mosques and Muslims. We need to raise 8,000 dollars to fund our Medical Relief outreach for this summer.
